# ITALIAN ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND FAMILY

Polypiù embodies the evolution of an entrepreneurial tradition rooted in Italian industry. Founded in 2006 by Domenico, Cristina and Elisabetta Moretti, the company carries on the legacy of Polyù Italiana Spa, established in the late 1970s by siblings Angelo and Vitale Moretti, pioneers in the European production of honeycomb polycarbonate systems. 2017 marked a strengthening of the link with the family roots through the entry of Andrea and Marco Moretti on the board of directors, ensuring continuity and a new impetus for the company, known for its commitment to innovation in the construction sector.





Today, **Polypiù** is a leading Italian manufacturer of polycarbonate systems and sheets, essential for roofing, curtain walling and industrial glazing. The company is a key partner for designers, installers and architects, offering effective, state-of-the-art solutions.

Looking to the future, Polypiù has expanded its international presence, opening new offices in Poland and Australia and increasing exports, which now reach 75 countries and account for 20% of total sales. In Italy, the historical pole in Corbetta has been joined by the new headquarters in Modugno (BA), strategic for relations with Southern Italy. Thanks to continuous investments in design and new production lines, **Polypiù** stands out on the market, responding promptly to customers' needs and anticipating industry trends.

The carpentry-built walkway and stairway was covered in the parapets and lower part with the Panelpiù 500/16 in a diffusing opaline colour, illuminated in the lower part with green LED. Thanks to the tongue-and-groove joint, the walkway appears as a continuous translucent element, providing a harmonious aesthetic effect with a strong visual impact.

#### Restyling of waste-to-energy plant in Desio (2022) / Desio, Italy

The restyling of the Desio waste-to-energy plant involved the use of **Panelpiù 500/40** in the two-tone version, with one colour on the outer face and another on the inner face. The orange on the outside gives a bright colour note, the opaline on the inside allows more light to diffuse when the cladding is backlit in the evening. The longest panels measure 17.8 m.

The new gymnasium in Olgiate Olona is characterised by a translucent volume made of **Panelpiù 500/55 14 Walls**, mounted in a double skin, which injects diffused light and establishes a relationship with the sky, also thanks to its mimetic ability to reflect different colours and transform chromatically depending on the time of day. The double skin provides excellent thermal and acoustic insulation values
